Types of Carpet Cleaners to Rent

One size doesn't always fit all. That's why we offer two types of Rug Doctor rental machines - the standard size and the larger Wide Track. We want everyone to experience Rug Doctor's incredible cleaning results, whatever their home's size or carpeted area.

Read on to learn about the Rug Doctor cleaning process, and to find out which machine is best for you. We want to make sure you pick the right model so you can rejuvenate your carpets and upholstery quickly and easily.



The Rug Doctor Cleaning Process

Both of our hire machines use a clever three-step process to achieve dazzling results:

- 1) **Inject** – Shoots cleaning solution deep into the carpet.
- 2) **Agitate** – The innovative vibrating brush buffs your carpet fibres, while the oscillating motion helps to loosen embedded dirt.
- 3) **Extract** – Removes dirt and excess moisture.



This process is so effective that it's even won awards for dirt and water removal, as well as carpet fibre retention. This means that Rug Doctor will extract an impressive amount of dirt from your carpet and promote a quicker drying time – all without damaging your carpet's pile!

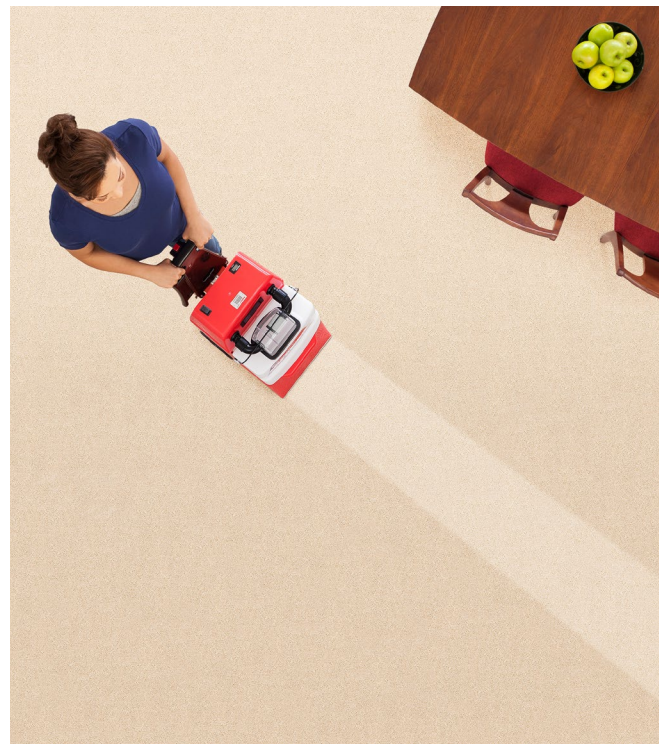
Our machines are also incredibly easy to use. When you collect your rental, all you need to do is pick up a leaflet (or if you opt for home delivery, this will come with the machine), which will have all the information you need to get started.



For most carpets, just pull the machine backwards with the spray feature activated.

Just bear in mind that the process varies slightly, depending on what you need to clean. For most carpets, just pull the machine backwards with the spray feature activated. For fabric, upholstery, car interiors and mattresses, you'll need to attach the Hand Tool.

Rug Doctor Machine

Our most popular rental machine, the standard Rug Doctor is best suited to average size carpeted areas. It measures only H25.5 x W11.5 x D22 inches, making the machine accessible and easy-to-use.

Unlike a vacuum cleaner, the Rug Doctor goes beyond the carpet's surface to extract deeply embedded grime – in just one pass! Our unique cleaning process wipes out all kinds of nasties, from skin particles and dust mite droppings to irritating allergens.

The machine also features a bi-directional oscillating brush – a unique feature which washes the cleaning solution deep down in the carpet pile. It then removes up to 80% of the solution, leaving the carpet almost dry.

Total drying time is usually only around two to four hours, dependent on conditions like room ventilation, central heating and outside temperature – so your home won't be disturbed for long. And, your old and tired looking carpets are left transformed in less than half a day.



Rug Doctor Wide Track

If your home has larger carpeted areas, then the Rug Doctor Wide Track is your best option. We've designed this machine to reduce cleaning time without compromising on performance – in fact, it's estimated that it cleans twice as fast as the standard Rug Doctor!

The Wide Track uses the same unique cleaning process as our standard model – just on a bigger scale. In terms of measurements, the Wide Track measures H27.5 x W13 x D24 inches, so it's still portable and user-friendly.



Compared to our standard machine, the Rug Doctor Wide Track has a 30% larger tank capacity and 16% wider cleaning path. This means it can cover a larger area, making emptying and refilling less frequent.

It's ideal for use in larger homes – simply fill the solution tank before turning on, and pull backwards to operate. Sound good to you? Our Wide Track machine is available for hire at major outlets like Homebase and B&Q.

It also features a built-in hand tool to tackle carpet, upholstery and interior stains. You can even refresh the inside of your car with the powerful brush, as this machine is IPX4 Splashproof rated for outdoor use.

- **Rug Doctor Deep Carpet Cleaner** – Make cleaning and drying your carpets easier than ever before with our award-winning Deep Carpet Cleaner. This compact model features an extra powerful vacuum to dry your carpets – ideal for hectic households. Its unique agitating brush leaves your carpets thoroughly clean, while the grooming brush leaves them looking plush. For carpets with stubborn stains and high traffic areas, the super boost spray feature enhances the cleaning results. It even features a removable tool caddy to clean upholstery, stairs, fabrics and car interiors.

Where to Use a Hire Machine

Rug Doctor machines have been designed to refresh tired carpets in your home – but their abilities don't end there!

Read on to find out where you can use our hired carpet cleaners:

- **Cut-pile carpets** – The most popular use for a Rug Doctor is to clean and revive your home's cut-pile carpets. Our machines clean deep into carpet fibres, removing dirt and grime buried beneath the surface.
- **Other carpets** – With a little extra care, you can even clean wool, Berber and shag-pile carpets. However, as these types hold more moisture, we recommend that you avoid over-wetting them. Just use the machine to go over carpets once and repeat vacuum only passes to remove as much moisture as possible. For wool/wool mix carpets, only use lukewarm water.

Our machines clean deep into carpet fibres, removing dirt and grime buried beneath the surface.



- **Area rugs** – As our name suggests, you can also use our hire machines on area rugs. Make sure to clean them away from floor types that could be damaged, including hardwood or laminate flooring.
- **Upholstery and Interiors** – You can even use a Rug Doctor to freshen up upholstery and vehicle interiors. Simply attach the Hand Tool (available at an additional cost) and use our [Oxy Power Fabric Cleaner](#) to renew your sofas and car interior. This attachment is also perfect for cleaning stairs and out-of-reach areas.
- **Mattresses** – Freshen up your old mattresses with the Rug Doctor. Attach the Hand Tool and clean one side of the mattress, then let it dry completely and repeat on the other side. Make sure you go over your cleaning paths on vacuum only afterwards – it's important that you don't over-wet your mattress.



You can even use a Rug Doctor to freshen up upholstery and vehicle interiors.

Where Not to Use a Rug Doctor

Although you can clean most common carpets with the Rug Doctor, some types aren't suitable and require specialist care.

These include:

- ✗ Oriental rugs (silk or wool)
- ✗ Dry-clean only carpets
- ✗ Hand-loomed or braided rugs
- ✗ Sisal or jute carpets
- ✗ Hard floors, including tiles, wood and laminate flooring.



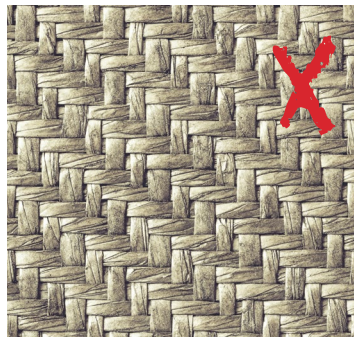

You should also take care when using the Hand Tool to clean smaller areas. The following materials shouldn't be cleaned using hot water extraction:



- ✗ Natural fibre
- ✗ Sea grass matting
- ✗ Silk
- ✗ Haitian cotton
- ✗ Ruylux
- ✗ Velvet
- ✗ Brushed corduroy
- ✗ Leather
- ✗ Non-colourfast fabrics
- ✗ Berber
- ✗ Flotex
- ✗ Memory foam (mattresses)

Simply spray it onto highly soiled areas 5-10 minutes before cleaning your carpets. It helps to break the bonds of dirt and grease, so when you use the machine, your carpets will be fresh and clean again in no time.
- **Urine Eliminator** – Knocks out nasty stains and odours, while acting as an effective pre-treatment before a Rug Doctor clean. It eliminates the hard urine crystals from dried-in stains, perfect for homes with pets and young children. Apply generously and keep the area moist with a damp towel, then let it dry naturally. Easy!

How Long to Hire the Rug Doctor

Rug Doctor Rental Period

When you hire a Rug Doctor, you'll need to decide how long you'd like to keep it. Your choice will largely depend on available time and the size of area you'll be cleaning. Need help deciding? In this section of our rental guide, we've set out everything you need to consider.

24-Hour Carpet Cleaner Rental

The shortest time you can hire a carpet cleaner for is 24 hours, from around £22.99 on average.

Only looking to clean a few rooms? Two average sized rooms take a couple of hours to complete, so 24 hours should be plenty of time.

Regardless of your home's size, you'll also need to think about how much of it is carpeted. If you have a large home with mainly hard flooring, it might make more sense for you to choose a 24-hour rental. The same goes for smaller houses and flats with fewer carpeted areas.

If you underestimate the time you need, then not to worry. Some stores allow you to extend your rental period – just give them a call to see how they can help.

Larger homes with more carpeted areas may also require extra rental time.

48-Hour Carpet Cleaner Rental

Our longest rental period gives you 48 hours to revitalise your dirty carpets, from around £28.99. Keep your eyes peeled for weekend deals as well!

From start to finish, including prep and drying times, an average three-bedroom home only takes a day to clean and dry. But, if you have a busy schedule, a longer rental period could give you added peace of mind, and the additional time easily offsets the small difference in price.

Larger homes with more carpeted areas may also require extra rental time. And, you'll need to consider whether you're going to use the Hand Tool attachment to clean upholstery, as this will take more time.

Plus, if you have a number of highly soiled areas, we recommend a second clean. This is up to you, but to make sure all embedded dirt and grime has been extracted, we recommend that you repeat the process after the first clean has had time to dry overnight. Be careful on wool and wool mix carpets though – these carpets are more sensitive to treatment and so we recommend only one pass.

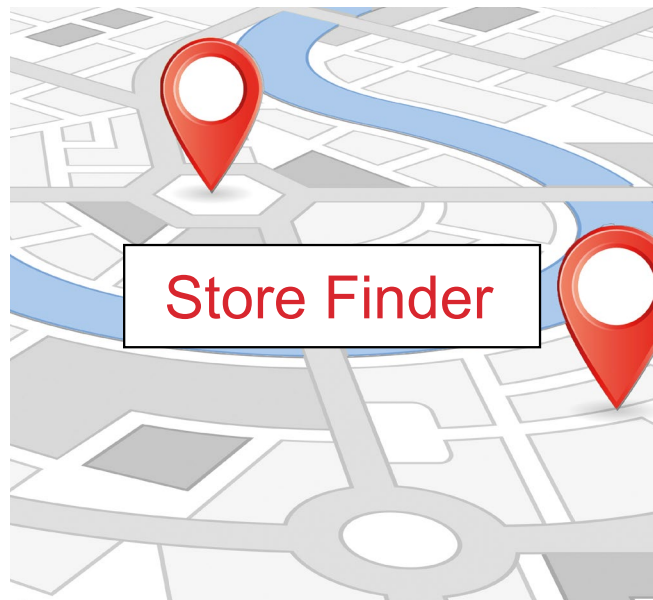

For ASDA, Tesco and selected Sainsbury's stores, you can easily book your rental online via the Store Finder. Simply follow the easy steps below to complete your online booking.

- 1. Find** your nearest store using the store finder.
- 2. Click** on the location and select the 'book online' option.
- 3. Select** your preferred date and time for collection, including the rental period.
- 4. Create** an account or log-in to your existing account.
- 5. To confirm** your booking, fill out the form with your payment details and contact number.

Unable to visit an outlet and hire a machine? Whether you have no means of transport or don't live nearby a rental store, you're not to worry.

Your easiest option is our home delivery service, which is available across the UK (excluding Northern Ireland). Simply decide whether you'd like your products to be delivered the next day or by standard delivery. It couldn't be easier!

Not only is home delivery convenient, but it's also affordable. For as low as £35 + delivery, you can rejuvenate your carpets and upholstery without even having to leave the house. We have an easy three-step process to follow – choose a hire period, your cleaning products and a delivery time:

- **Hire period** – A 24-hour rental costs around £22.99, while a 48-hour rental costs around £28.99.
- **Cleaning products** – We have a range of detergent types and sizes, from £9.99.
- **Delivery time** – Standard delivery costs £15, while next day delivery costs £25.

Collecting and Returning a Rug Doctor

As part of our rental service, you'll need to consider how to collect and return your carpet cleaner.

The process depends on whether you've gone for home delivery, or local store collection. Want to find out how to get started? We've simplified the steps to take – just keep on reading to find out more.

Rug Doctor In-Store Collection

Self-Service Locker Collection - When you book a Rug Doctor online or by phone, some large stores offer self-service lockers. On booking confirmation, you'll be given a locker number and code.

In the store, find the Rug Doctor display by the checkout. First, choose and purchase your cleaning products at the checkout. Find your assigned locker and enter your code, then check that the machine number matches yours. If everything seems correct, take the machine and a welcome pack. It's that easy – no form is required!

Before you leave the store, check that the machine is in a clean condition. If it doesn't meet your high expectations, report it to our [Customer Services Team](#).

On booking confirmation, you'll be given a locker number and code.



Customer Service Collection - If you book your rental in-store* or choose an outlet without self-service lockers, you can go to the customer service desk to begin the process. They will be happy to help, but if you need some help from us too, feel free to call our [Customer Services Team](#). Also, you can rest assured that your machine will be checked for cleanliness by staff before it's handed over to you.

You'll need at least two forms of ID to hire a Rug Doctor this way:

- **Photo ID & Card** - If you're paying by credit or debit card, bring some photo ID (driving license or passport) along with your card.
- **Photo ID & Statements** - If you're paying with cash, we accept household bills or bank statements together with photo ID.

Rug Doctor Cleaning Products

In addition to your carpet cleaner rental, there are some other items to consider.

To get the best results, you'll need the right cleaning products to treat your carpet and upholstery emergencies:

- **Carpet Detergent** – As part of our rental experience, you'll need to purchase some Rug Doctor Carpet Cleaning Detergent. There are three types available, which cover pet accidents, stubborn stains, as well as fabric and upholstery. If you're collecting the machine in-store, you'll find the products at the Rug Doctor stand, ready to purchase at the store's checkouts. Or, if you've gone for home delivery, you can select your cleaning products during the booking process.
- **Pre-treatments** – Are your carpets in need of maximum cleaning power? You can also purchase pre-treatments like our [High Foot Traffic](#), [Urine Eliminator](#) and [Spot and Stain Remover](#) trigger sprays. Dependent on the spray, these can help break the bonds of dirt and grease or wipe out nasty stains.
- **Hand Tool Attachment** – Looking to clean smaller areas and upholstery? The Hand Tool attachment is also available to rent with the machine, letting you tackle hard-to-reach areas. However, this is an optional extra, so you don't have to rent with the machine if you only plan to clean large, carpeted areas.



Returning Your Rental In-Store

Once you've finished using the Rug Doctor, you'll need to make sure you return it in a good, clean condition.

We recommend that you take the following steps before returning your machine:

- **Empty** any remaining solution from the red base tank. If you've chosen to rent the Hand Tool, you can use this to spray the solution into a sink.
- **Empty** solution from the white recovery tank into a sink.
- **Clean** inside the clear dome and the filter.
- **Remove** any carpet residue, lint and other dirt from the brush and bottom of the machine.
- **Wind** the cable around the handle and secure the plug in place.
- If you've rented the Hand Tool, make sure you **disconnect** it from the machine and re-attach the carpet cleaning hoses.
- **Pack** the Hand Tool into its mesh carry bag.

Then, all you need to do is drop it off at the selected store before the end of your rental period.

If you used self-service, return the machine by opening the locker with the same code you used to open it. Place the machine and Hand Tool inside, then close and lock the door.

Some outlets may also require a deposit to ensure that the machine is returned in a clean condition. If it's returned late, some stores may charge a penalty, but most allow you to extend the rental period at an additional cost. Just give them a call before your rental expires to check for availability.



Rug Doctor Collection

If you choose our home delivery service, we'll collect the machine at your door once your rental period has ended. The collection time will be between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm – so you'll need to be available during this period.
